

Rules changes for 2011-12

Glenda Hall Shield

- Now an 11-a-side competition
- Teams must have 7 players from their own club to take the field
- Players may still be shared between teams
- Batters can still bat again, up to 10 wickets to fall
- Retire at 50 runs for all players (may retire earlier)
- Team sheets provided by CACT – must be completed and handed to umpires by captains (umpires to return with match paperwork please) – underage players and designated players must be noted on the team sheet
- Designated players – retire at 30 and can only bat again if all other batters (retired and dismissed) have batted a second time and 10 wickets have not fallen.
- Wides – outside 75cm on either side of stumps

- Addition of the One1 Eliminator in the case of a Tied match as per WNCL
